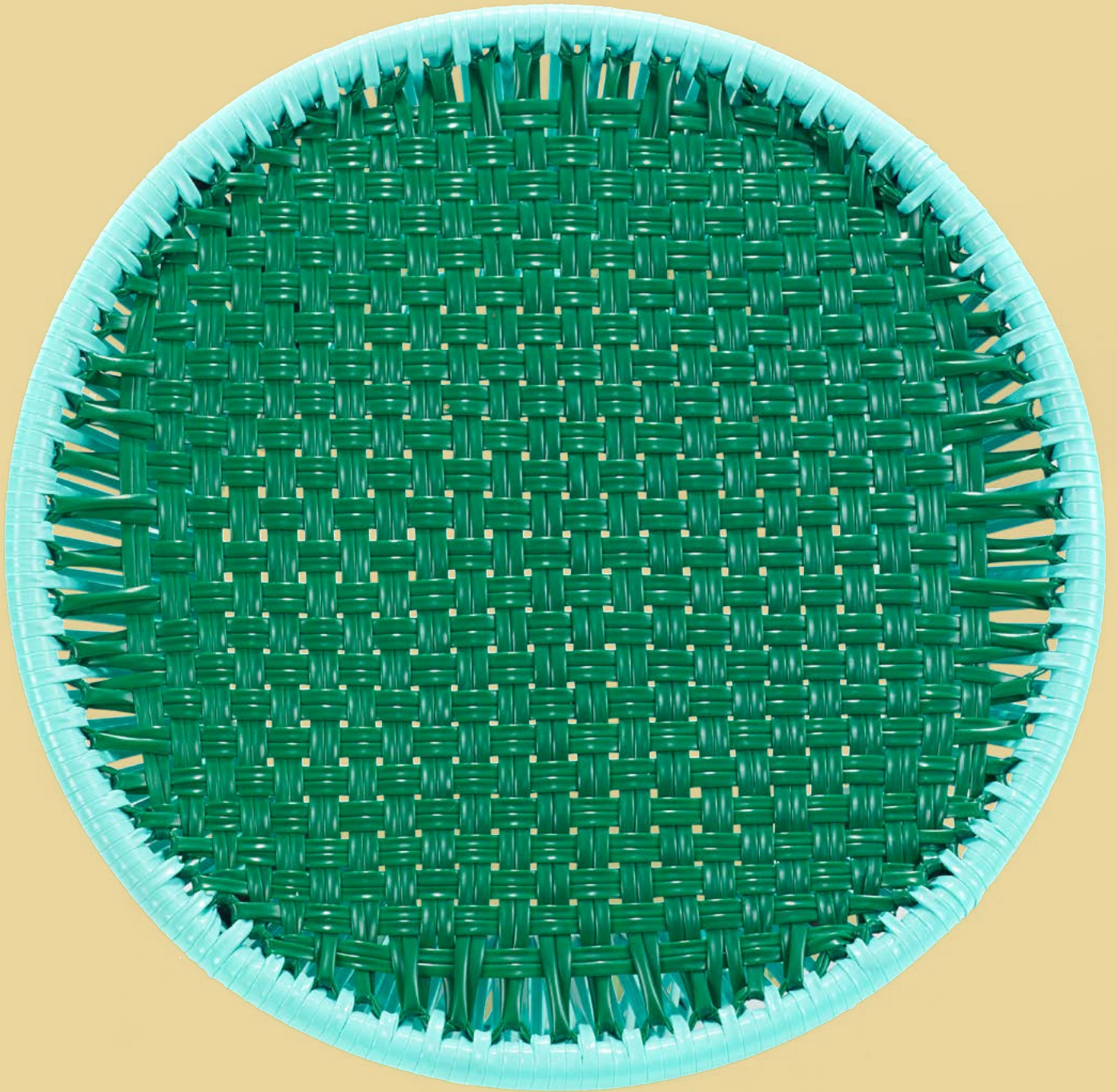

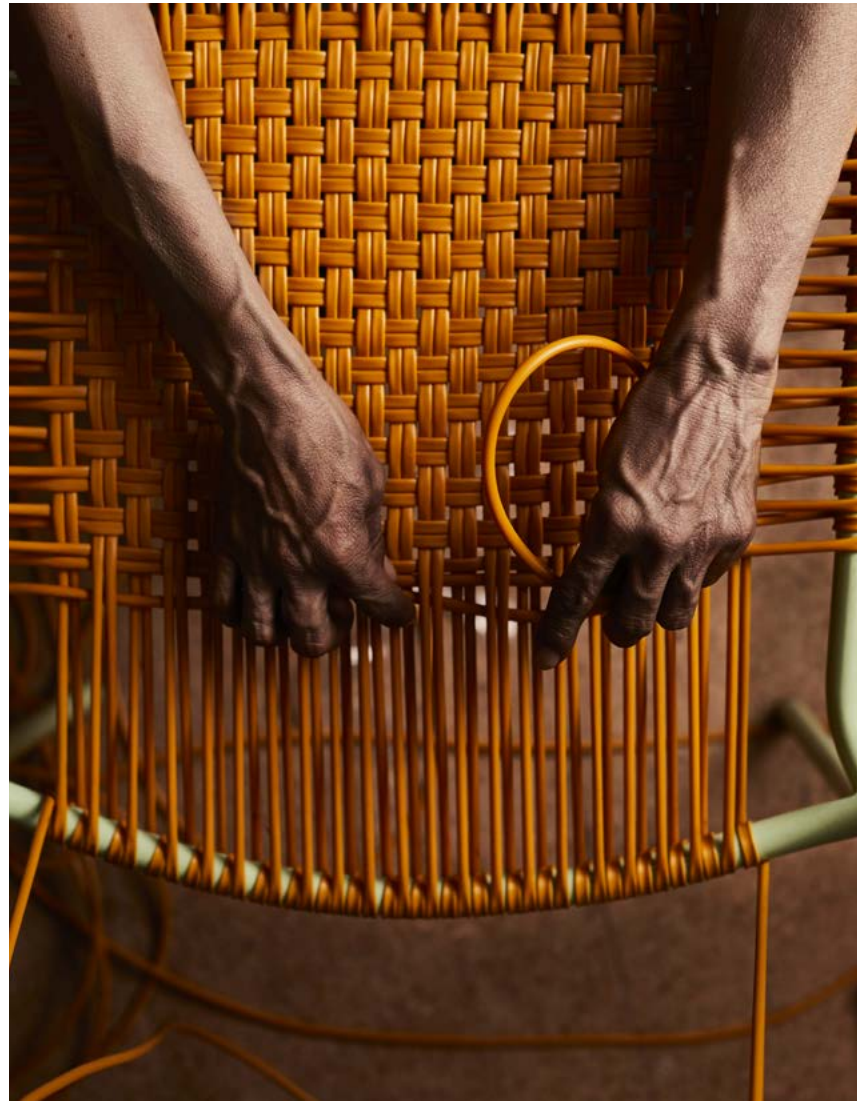
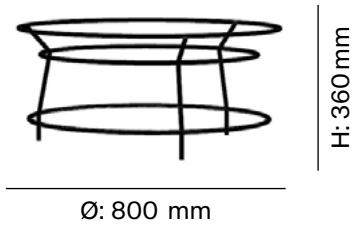

### Craft and manufacturing

Each table is made in Santa Marta, a city on the Caribbean coast of Colombia, by local craftspeople. They weave the PVC strings, which are made from recycled plastic, around the tubular steel frame. The weaving technique the artesanos and artesanas use is called Momposino, a traditional method known for intricate patterns. Just the preparation of all the materials takes ten days, while the production of each bench takes four days.

### Care Instructions

Wipe clean with a damp cloth, do not use chemical cleanser. To protect the colours, avoid exposing the product to direct sunlight over longer periods. Protect the product with a cover or store it indoors during winter or harsh weather conditions. If the product is exposed to sea air, wipe it regularly with a damp cloth (no chemical cleansers). Fitted cover sold separately.
